Two Palestinians were killed in an Israeli drone strike east of Khan Yunis as Israel continued to violate the Gaza ceasefire with new air, land, and sea attacks.

Meanwhile, Hamas announced it found the body of an Israeli prisoner in Gaza City and will hand it over to the Red Cross, as the US pressures the movement to expedite recovery efforts amid Israel's growing threats to resume military action.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 68,527 and injured 170,395 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.
