Medical sources in Gaza reported that 42 Palestinians were killed in Israeli airstrikes across several areas of the Strip since the morning.

Meanwhile, a Hamas delegation led by Khalil al-Hayya arrived in Cairo to discuss ceasefire implementation as Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu ordered a halt to airstrikes following US pressure and mounting civilian casualties in Gaza.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 68,159 and injured 170,203 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.
