Israeli airstrikes have intensified across the Gaza Strip, targeting multiple areas as destruction and displacement continue despite the ceasefire agreement.

At the same time, Israeli forces have expanded their military operations in the occupied West Bank, with large-scale raids and closures reported in the Tubas area.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 69,775 and injured 170,965 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

## **Amnesty: Israel is ‘Still Committing Genocide’ in Gaza despite Ceasefire**
