Al-Quds Hospital in Gaza reported that at least 12 Palestinian aid seekers were killed and over 124 were injured near the Netzarim axis, south of Gaza City.

Meanwhile, Israeli Channel 13 reported that 8 of the “Madleen” ship activists refused to sign deportation procedures and will be detained and forcibly deported.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 54,927 and injured 126,615 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

World Food Program Warns of Famine in Gaza

STATEMENT: The World Food Program said that since May 19th, it has only been able to bring in limited quantities of life-saving aid to Gaza:

Since the resumption of aid, we have brought in only 700 trucks compared to 600-700 trucks that used to enter daily.

To avert famine, we need to regularly support Gaza's residents by meeting their basic food needs.

The fear of famine within the Gaza Strip remains extremely high.

The entry of aid requires providing safe routes for convoys, accelerating permit approvals, and opening crossings.

The petition stated that the government destroyed the exchange deal and that the Israeli army's bombing killed many of them.
