

# GAZA LIVE BLOG: 210 Killed, Over 400 Wounded in Israeli Massacre in Nuseirat | Numbers Expected to Rise – Day 246

The Ministry of Health in the Gaza Strip called on the international community to provide electricity generators to hospitals to prevent a major health disaster.

Several Palestinians were killed and wounded in the continuous bombardment and artillery shelling carried out by Israeli forces.

The Israeli army admitted that Hezbollah launched a drone at Marj Bin Amer and air defenses failed to intercept it.

According to Gaza's Ministry of Health, 36,731 Palestinians have been killed, and 83,530 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7.

## **LATEST UPDATES**

**Sunday, June 9, 03:30 am (GMT +2)**

### **PALESTINIAN MEDIA:**

Artillery shelling and heavy fire from Israeli tanks continue to target the center and north of the city of Rafah.

Israeli shelling targeted a house in the Maghazi refugee camp in the central Gaza Strip.

Israeli artillery shelling targeted areas east of the city of Deir al-Balah in the central Gaza Strip.

Three people, including a child, were killed and seven wounded, including children, in an Israeli shelling that targeted a house in Al-Daraj neighborhood in the center of Gaza City.

One person was injured when Israeli warplanes targeted a house in Al-Daraj neighborhood in the center of Gaza City.

CENTCOM: US Central Command (CENTCOM) said that the pier was not used in the Israeli operation to recover detainees in Gaza, noting that the Israelis used the area south of the pier to repatriate prisoners. (Video footage and media reports indicate direct US involvement in the operation and the great massacre of Nuseirat.)

### **Sunday, June 9, 01:00 am (GMT +2)**

ISRAELI POLICE: 33 people were arrested in Tel Aviv demonstrations.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Gantz will hold political consultations on Sunday, regarding the date of his resignation from the government.

US STATE DEPARTMENT: We welcome the rescue of Israeli captives and Washington will not rest until all the captives are returned home. A ceasefire could lead to the reconstruction of Gaza and a permanent end to the war.

### **Sunday, June 9, 12:00 am (GMT +2)**

AL-JAZEERA: an Israeli raid targeted a house in the Al-Dawa area, east of the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip

YEDIOTH AHRONOTH (citing Israeli official): The recovery of 4 detainees will not affect Hamas' demands.

AL-JAZEERA: An Israeli drone raid on the town of Aitaroun in southern Lebanon, while three missiles were launched from southern Lebanon towards the Upper Galilee.

### **Saturday, June 8, 11:00 pm (GMT +2)**

CBS (citing US official): Any claim that Israel used the temporary dock is false.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Confrontations erupt between Israeli police and demonstrators demanding a deal.

KAN: The Israeli Broadcasting Authority quoted those close to the minister in the war government, Benny Gantz, as saying that despite the news they described as "good" after the recovery of the four detainees, the orientations of Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu have not changed, stressing that they do not want local success.

US MEDIA: Hundreds of Americans demonstrated in front of the White House in Washington, DC, to demand an end to the war on the Gaza Strip and to denounce the massacre committed by the occupation in the Nuseirat camp in the central Strip.

ISRAELI ARMY: We did not enter Nuseirat in the central Gaza Strip in an aid truck or via the sea pier.

**Saturday, June 8, 10:00 pm (GMT +2)**

HEZBOLLAH: We bombed a building used by Israeli occupation soldiers in the Metulla settlement, confirming a direct hit.

AL-QUDS BRIGADES: We bombed the settlements surrounding the Gaza Strip with missile salvos.

KAN: Israeli military and security leaders are holding discussions about the impact of the Nuseirat operation on the prisoner exchange deal.

KAN (citing informed sources): The operation to recover the four detainees in Nuseirat in the central Gaza Strip was planned more than a month ago, and the soldiers conducted training on expected scenarios.

**Saturday, June 8, 9:00 pm (GMT +2)**

ISRAELI MEDIA: Netanyahu called on Gantz not to resign from the emergency government.

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted a building used by Israeli occupation soldiers in the Kfaryoufal settlement with missiles and we bombed the headquarters of the Sahel Battalion in the Beit Hillel barracks using a Falaq 2 rocket launcher for the first time.

EU FOREIGN POLICY CHIEF BORRELL: Reports received about another massacre against civilians are horrific.

IRAN: The massacre committed by the occupation in the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip came as a result of the inability of countries and international organizations – especially the Security Council – in the face of 8 months of ongoing Israeli war crimes in the Strip.

JORDAN: Jordan condemned what it described as a brutal attack in the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip, stressing that it reflects the systematic targeting of civilians and a violation of international law.

**Saturday, June 8, 7:40 pm (GMT +2)**

ABU OBEIDA:

“What the Zionist enemy carried out in the Nuseirat area in the central Gaza Strip is a compounded war crime, and the first to be harmed by it are its captives.

“The enemy managed to liberate some of its captives by committing horrific massacres, but at the same time, it killed some of them during the operation.

“The operation will pose a great danger to the enemy’s captives and will have a negative impact on their conditions and lives.”

**Saturday, June 8, 7:30 pm (GMT +2)**

**FAMILIES OF ISRAELI CAPTIVES:** Families of Israeli prisoners said at a conference in Tel Aviv that not all detainees can be returned through special operations and the only way to return them is to stop the war and conclude an exchange deal.

**COLOMBIAN PRESIDENT:** Colombian President Gustavo Petro announced that his country would stop its coal exports to Israel as its war on the Gaza Strip continued, and said that exports would not return until the genocide stopped.

**AL-JAZEERA:** There were two raids by Israeli drones on the town of Hula and the outskirts of Majdal Zoun in southern Lebanon.

**AL-QASSAM BRIGADES:**

We targeted two Israeli D-9 bulldozers with a Tandom shell and a shock device east of the Al-Zaytoun neighborhood in Gaza City.

We detonated an anti-personnel device with Israeli force inside a house, confirming that it killed and wounded its members east of the Zaytoun neighborhood in the central Gaza Strip

**EGYPTIAN FM:** Egypt condemned the Israeli targeting of the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip, and stressed that it is a blatant violation of all provisions of international and humanitarian law and all values of humanity and human rights.

**AL-JAZEERA:** Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas instructed the Palestinian representative to the United Nations, Riyad Mansour, to request that an emergency session of the Security Council be held to discuss the repercussions of the Nuseirat massacre

**Saturday, June 8, 6:30 pm (GMT +2)**

**KIRBY:** The United States supports the return of detainees through ongoing negotiations or other means.

**AL-QASSAM BRIGADES:** In conjunction with the Martyr Abu Ali Mustafa Brigades, targeted an Apache helicopter with a SAM 7 missile in the sky of the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip.

**BIDEN:** US President Joe Biden welcomed – during a press conference in Paris – the return of the four Israeli captives, indicating that we will continue to work for the return of all detainees and a ceasefire in the Gaza Strip.

**HAMAS:** Recovering the prisoners will not change the failure of the strategic occupation.

**Saturday, June 8, 5:30 pm (GMT +2)**

**GAZA GOVERNMENT MEDIA OFFICE:** The death toll resulting from the Nusseirat market massacre in the central Gaza Strip has reached 210, in addition to 400 wounded.

**Saturday, June 8, 5:00 pm (GMT +2)**

**GALLANT:** The recovery of the captives took place in a “complex urban” environment.

GAZA GOVERNMENT MEDIA OFFICE: The government media office in Gaza sent a distress call to the international community to save Al-Aqsa Martyrs Hospital and provide the necessary medical supplies.

**Saturday, June 8, 4:30 pm (GMT +2)**

YEDIOTH AHRONOTH: An officer in the Israeli Yamam Unit was killed during the operation to recover the four captives in Nuseirat in the central Gaza Strip.

AXIOS: A US official told Axios the US “hostage cell” in Israel supported the effort to rescue the four Israeli captives.

NETANYAHU: Israel is committed to returning detainees.

PRCS IN GAZA: The occupation forces carried out a mass killing operation that claimed the lives of dozens wounded many others in Nuseirat and areas of the central Gaza Strip.

**Saturday, June 8, 3:30 pm (GMT +2)**

NYT: Israel has increased its use of American GBU-39 guided bombs since the beginning of the year.

FAMILIES OF ISRAELI CAPTIVES: The government must remember that it is its duty to return all 12 detainees.

YEDIOTH AHRONOTH: A technical malfunction occurred in the Israeli army vehicle that was carrying 3 freed detainees, which led to it stopping.

ISRAELI MILITARY SPOKESMAN: We carried out the operation based on intelligence information and operations by Shin Bet and Yamam.

PALESTINE CHRONICLE CORRESPONDENT: At least 80 people were killed or wounded in Israeli raids targeting the Nuseirat camp and areas of the central Gaza Strip.

GAZA GOVERNMENT MEDIA OFFICE: The occupation had a premeditated intention to carry out the Nuseirat massacres. We call on the international community to stop the genocidal war immediately and urgently.

YEDIOTH AHRONOTH: Gantz postponed the press conference that was scheduled today following the liberation of 4 Israeli captives.

**Saturday, June 8, 2:00 pm (GMT +2)**

ISMAIL HANIYEH: Hamas will not agree to any agreement that does not achieve security for the Palestinian people.

ISRAELI ARMY: The Israeli army said that it freed 4 kidnapped Israelis from the heart of Nuseirat.

AL-QUDS BRIGADES: We killed and wounded an Israeli special force by targeting a house in which they had barricaded themselves in the Saudi neighborhood, west of Rafah.

AL-JAZEERA: Sirens sounded in Kissufim in the Gaza Strip.

**Saturday, June 8, 11:30 am (GMT +2)**

AL-QASSAM BRIGADES: We exploded a minefield with Israeli engineering force near the crossing line east of the city of Rafah, noting that it left its members dead and wounded.

HEZBOLLAH: We bombed the Israeli Zarit barracks and achieved a direct hit.

AL-AQSA MARTYRS HOSPITAL: The failure of electricity generators in hospitals leads to a major health disaster

ISRAEL HAYOM: Former Mossad official Haim Tomer said that a widespread war with Hezbollah would undermine Israel's ability to function as a state.

TURKISH FM: The occupation crimes in Gaza are a disgrace on Israel.

AL-JAZEERA: Sirens sounded in the Zarit area in the Upper Galilee in anticipation of missile launches from Lebanon.

CNN: American officials – who resigned publicly due to President Joe Biden's policy in Gaza – are working together to support the opposition and put pressure on the administration.

AL-QASSAM BRIGADES: We targeted an Israeli Apache helicopter with a SAM-7 missile east of the city of Rafah, south of the Gaza Strip.

ISRAELI ARMY: Hezbollah launched a drone tonight at Marj Bin Amer, 40 km away, and air defenses failed to intercept it.

**Saturday, June 8, 10:00 am (GMT +2)**

GAZA HEALTH MINISTRY: We call on the international community and relief organizations to provide electricity generators to the Gaza Strip's hospitals.

**Saturday, June 8, 09:00 am (GMT +2)**

AL-JAZEERA: Six were killed and others were injured in an Israeli bombing that targeted a house in the Bureij refugee camp in the central Gaza Strip.

ISLAMIC RESISTANCE IN IRAQ: We targeted a vital target inside the occupied Palestinian territories at dawn today with drones.

**Saturday, June 8, 08:00 am (GMT +2)**

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted a position of Israeli soldiers in a newly developed artillery range in Seneim in the occupied Shebaa Farms, using an assault drone.

**Saturday, June 8, 06:00 am (GMT +2)**

AL-JAZEERA: Sirens sounded in several areas north of the occupied Golan for fear of a drone infiltration.

**Saturday, June 8, 05:00 am (GMT +2)**

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: The Israeli occupation artillery continued its shelling of areas southeast of the Bureij refugee camp in the central Gaza Strip.

**Saturday, June 8, 04:00 am (GMT +2)**

AL-JAZEERA: Israeli artillery fired incendiary shells, and fires broke out in the Oreiba area, north of the city of Rafah.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Israeli raids and artillery shelling targeted the Bureij camp in the central Gaza Strip.

**Saturday, June 8, 03:00 am (GMT +2)**

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted with artillery shells a group of Israeli occupation soldiers at the Raheb site.

**Saturday, June 8, 02:00 am (GMT +2)**

AL-JAZEERA: Sirens sounded in several areas in the Upper Galilee on the border with Lebanon.
