The International Court of Justice (ICJ) ruled on Wednesday that Israel is obliged to ensure that the population of the Gaza Strip has "the basic needs" essential for survival in accordance with international humanitarian law.

Meanwhile, the Al-Quds Brigades' new spokesperson, Abu Hamza, vowed to continue armed resistance against Israel, honoring his slain predecessor and reaffirming unity among Palestinian factions amid what he called a "war of extermination."

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 68,234 and injured 170,373 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

WHO Warns of Generational Health Disaster:

The Director-General of the World Health Organization (WHO) stated that Gaza is witnessing a "health catastrophe that will last for generations." He noted restrictions on aid access and urged Israel to allow relief organizations previously denied registration to return to Gaza.

WFP: Food Systems Destroyed):

The World Food Programme (WFP) said that "food systems in Gaza are destroyed and access to basic needs is extremely limited."

Fragile Ceasefire Hope:

The Deputy UN Coordinator for the Peace Process in the region described the Gaza agreement as a "very fragile hope" that must be built upon toward a comprehensive agreement. He emphasized that the destruction in Gaza is immense and called for a robust aid coordination mechanism.

Casualty Update:

The Gaza Ministry of Health reported that the total number of casualties from the Israeli aggression has risen to 68,280 killed and 170,375 injured since October 7, 2023.

Lieberman Vows to Block Palestinian State:

Avigdor Lieberman, leader of the Yisrael Beiteinu party, declared, "We will not allow the establishment of a Palestinian state."

Arab/Islamic Condemnation:

A statement by Arab and Islamic countries welcomed the ICJ ruling on Israel's obligations and condemned the Knesset's approval of preliminary bills to impose Israeli sovereignty over the West Bank.

Netanyahu's Office Blames Opposition:

The Israeli Prime Minister's office said the Knesset vote on annexation was a "deliberate provocation by the opposition" to sow division during Vice President Vance's visit.

Haaretz reported that Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu "issued instructions not to proceed" with bills regarding the imposition of sovereignty in the West Bank and Ma'ale Adumim.

Trump: Gaza War is Over:

President Donald Trump told Time magazine that the "war in Gaza is over" and that Netanyahu must accept the agreement.

Trump on Marwan Barghouti:

Trump said he would make a decision on the possibility of Israel releasing Marwan Barghouti to lead post-war Gaza, but stressed that Hamas must disarm.

Warning on West Bank Annexation:

Trump warned that Israel "will lose all American support" if it annexes the West Bank, stating that he promised Arab nations it would not happen.

Condemning Attack on Qatar:

Trump stated that Netanyahu committed a "major tactical mistake" by attacking Qatar, calling the attack so weird that it drove everyone to do what they had to do.

Ben-Gvir Rejects Barghouti Release:

National Security Minister Itamar Ben-Gvir criticized Trump's talk of Marwan Barghouti, stating, "Israel is a sovereign state and Marwan Barghouti is a murderer and will not be released and will not govern Gaza."

EU Condemns Settler Attacks on Olive Harvest:

The European Union Representative in Palestine expressed concern over the escalating attacks against Palestinians during the olive harvest season in the occupied West Bank.

The EU strongly condemns the violence committed by illegal settlers and stressed that denying Palestinian farmers access to their land is absolutely unjustifiable.

The Representative emphasized that achieving sustainable peace requires addressing onthe-ground violations and ensuring respect for human rights and international law.

158 Attacks Recorded:

The Wall and Settlement Resistance Commission reported monitoring 158 attacks on olive harvesters in the West Bank since the start of the current season.

WHO Evacuates 41 Critical Patients:

The Director-General of the World Health Organization (WHO), Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus, announced the evacuation of 41 critically ill patients and 145 companions from Gaza for treatment abroad.

This is the first medical evacuation since the ceasefire began, with about 15,000 patients still awaiting approval for care outside Gaza.

New Aid Convoy Enters Gaza:

A new aid convoy loaded with thousands of tons of food and medical supplies departed from Egypt toward the Gaza Strip. The trucks, including those affiliated with the UN, are subject to the inspection and review mechanism imposed by the Israeli army.

Gaza Mayor Requests Rubble Removal Equipment:

The Mayor of Gaza City demanded the provision of necessary equipment to clear the extensive rubble in the Gaza Strip.

Since the Gaza ceasefire took effect, civil defense teams have resumed efforts to recover the bodies of Palestinians buried under the rubble after two years of Israeli bombardment.

However, severe shortages in equipment and heavy machinery continue to hinder progress.

Ibrahim Abu Rish, head of Gaza's civil defense field teams, told Al-Jazeera that "the world mobilizes all its capabilities to recover the bodies of 20 Israelis, while leaving nearly 10,000 Palestinian victims under the rubble without providing the machinery needed to retrieve them."

He accused Israel of delaying the delivery of heavy equipment needed to recover bodies and called on mediators and Washington to pressure Tel Aviv to implement the deal.
