Gaza's Civil Defense has stated that Israeli soldiers deliberately shoot at civilians who cross or are near the line by mistake.

Meanwhile, from Nablus to Hebron, Israeli forces stormed Palestinian towns as settlers carried out arson and stone attacks, marking another night of escalating violence across the occupied West Bank.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 68,519 and injured 170,382 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

He said Israel must eliminate Hamas, which now controls half the Strip, and that is why he opposed the agreement. He added that the supreme aim of the war is to eliminate Hamas, and that objective should have been a priority before the return of the captives.

News Roundup: Trump 'Proud' of Ceasefire Deal; Gaza Aid Status Unimproved as Israeli Hardliners Demand Violence

Health Aid Unimproved:

The World Health Organization (WHO) stated that there has been no improvement in the quantities of food and medicine reaching the Gaza Strip since the ceasefire began.

Homes Demolished:

The Israeli army demolished residential buildings in eastern Gaza for the fourth time this night, with loud explosions reported in the area.

Shooting in Khan Yunis:

Israeli army vehicles fired shots heavily in the area east of Khan Yunis.

Attacks on Fishermen:

Israeli naval vessels fired on fishing boats off the coast of Gaza City.

Trump ‘Proud’ of Ceasefire:

US President Donald Trump, speaking at the ASEAN Summit in Kuala Lumpur, said the US is proud to have signed the agreement to stop the war in Gaza and appreciates the participation of countries including Malaysia.

Ben-Gvir Rejects US ‘Guardianship’:

Israeli National Security Minister Itamar Ben-Gvir affirmed his respect for President Trump but stressed, “We are a sovereign, independent state and are not under the guardianship of Washington.” Ben-Gvir reiterated his opposition to the ceasefire, arguing the primary goal should have been “eliminating Hamas,” which he claims controls half of the Strip.

Rabbi Calls for Killing Released Captives:

Al-Jazeera reported that Shmuel Eliyahu, the Chief Rabbi of Safed, called on Israelis (civilians, military, and security personnel) to kill the Palestinian prisoners released in exchange deals.

International Support for ICJ Case:

Malaysia and Brazil confirmed their support for South Africa’s genocide case against Israel at the International Court of Justice (ICJ) in The Hague.

Gas Bombs on Students:

Israeli forces fired sound and gas bombs at Palestinian students heading to school in the town of Burqa, northwest of Nablus.

Palestinian Injured Near Jerusalem:

The Palestinian Red Crescent reported a Palestinian was injured by Israeli gunfire near the Al-Ram wall, north of Jerusalem.

Raid in Ramallah:

Israeli forces raided homes during an incursion into the Jalazone refugee camp, north of Ramallah.

Mass Arrests:

The Israeli army arrested 19 Palestinians, including 15 workers attempting to enter Israel for employment.
