Israeli bombardment of Gaza City on Saturday killed at least 62 Palestinians, destroyed a residential tower and multiple shelters, and drew UN warnings of an imminent humanitarian catastrophe.

Meanwhile, Israeli forces have escalated raids and mass arrests across the occupied West Bank, detaining more than 1,500 in Tulkarm, injuring residents, and attacking refugee camps under a months-long blockade.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 64,871 and injured 164,610 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

# News Roundup: Israeli Airstrikes Kill and Wound Dozens in Gaza

#### **Deadly Strikes on Homes and Tents**

Israeli airstrikes on two homes in the Sheikh Radwan neighborhood of northern Gaza City resulted in several casualties and injuries. In western Gaza, an airstrike on a tent sheltering displaced people killed six Palestinians, including children, according to Al-Shifa Hospital.

#### Strikes on Civilian Infrastructure

Israeli aircraft bombed two homes on Al-Jalaa Street in Gaza City, injuring several people and prompting calls for rescue teams to search for those missing under the rubble.

An airstrike also targeted the Al-Ashi Tower behind Al-Quds Hospital in the Tal al-Hawa neighborhood, causing injuries.

In the Al-Rimal neighborhood, an Israeli strike on a displaced persons' tent behind Capital Mall injured several people.

#### West Bank Raids and Arrests

Israeli forces arrested two young men from the town of Deir Jarir, east of Ramallah, and raided the Balata refugee camp east of Nablus and the town of Beit Ummar north of Hebron.

Other raids were also carried out in the towns of Deir Dibwan, Yatta, and Sa'ir.

Israeli occupation forces conducted a wave of random arrests in the southern district of Tulkarm in the northern West Bank.

### Solidarity Rally in Morocco

Hundreds of Moroccans gathered in a solidarity rally in Tetouan to support the Flotilla of Resilience and condemn the Israeli attacks on Gaza. Protesters chanted slogans in support of the Palestinian resistance and also condemned the recent Israeli attack on Doha.
